WHEREAS, the MRFPD will compensate its employees portal to portal while in the Course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an Emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency Response, and

WHEREAS, the MRFPD will compensate its employees overtime in accordance with their current Memorandum of Understanding while in the course of their employment and awayfrom their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the MRFPD Board of Directors that:

- Personnel shall be compensated according to Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), Personnel Rules and Regulations, and/or other directive that identifies personnel compensation in the workplace.
- 2. In the event a personnel classification does not have and assigned compensation rate, a "Base Rate" as set forth in an organizational policy, administrative directive or similar document will compensate such personnel.
- 3. The MRFPD will maintain a <u>current</u> salary survey or acknowledgement of acceptance for the "base rate" on file with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, Fire Rescue Division.

- 4. Personnel will be compensated (portal to portal) beginning at the time of dispatch to the return to jurisdiction when equipment and personnel are in service and available for agency response.
- 5. MRFPD response personnel include Fire Chief, Deputy Chief, Division Chief, Assistant Chief, and Battalion Chief, Captain, Engineer, Firefighter.
